Dear Hoover Neighbors,

The Burlingame School District and its Board of Trustees have continued to move ahead with the planned reopening of Hoover Elementary School. As part of this process the District is exploring a number of options. Three alternates were presented to the Board for comment at the meeting on July 28th. Information and drawings for each of the three alternates is available on the District's website. From the homepage, [www.bsd.k12.ca.us](http://www.bsd.k12.ca.us), look under the Our Schools tab – Elementary Schools – Hoover.

The three options are:

- Alternate A: Rehabilitate main building and annex
- Alternate B: Rehabilitate both existing buildings and build a new 4 classroom addition
- Alternate C: Rehabilitate the main building and replace the annex with a new 8 classroom addition

The Board directed staff to further explore Alternates A & C and bring further information to the meeting on August 23rd at 7pm. At that time the Board of Trustees will take comments on the proposed alternates and is scheduled to give direction on which alternate to pursue. All are invited to attend this meeting at the District Office to comment on this issue, or prior to the meeting questions and comments can be sent to the District via Assistant Superintendent, Chief Business Official, Dr. Robert Clark, through email, [rclark@bsd.k12.ca.us](mailto:rclark@bsd.k12.ca.us), or by phone at (650) 259-3800.

Once direction is given on which alternate to pursue, the District and it's consultants will begin the traffic study and environmental analysis. This decision is one of many to come that will continue to shape the future of Hoover.
